

### **Newsletters and Website**

Regular communication to keep orchestra families informed about events, updates, and student achievements

### **Fundraising Initiatives**

Football game parking lot sales, Football concession stand operations, Nutcracker performance concessions, Orchestra-themed merchandise design and sales

### **Student Support**

Providing meals during extended rehearsals and special events Assisting with costs for travel and performances Supporting enrichment opportunities through guest clinicians

#### **Event Coordination**

Planning and preparation of the annual orchestra Banquet, Assistance with camp, concerts, festivals, and other key performances

## Financial Update – Income Streams

### Donations and Fundraising

- ·Fall fundraiser campaigns provide 80% of the funding used by EOPA to support program activities
  - ·Goal of \$40K split between schools based upon number of students in orchestra
- ·Fundraising activities such as parking lot, concession and merchandise sales provide the remaining funds

### ·Extracurricular Payments

- ·EOPA collects money for the extracurricular activities that students may choose to participate in above and beyond participation in program activities such as
  - ·Orchestra summer camps
  - ·High school senior banquet
- ·Payments are used to cover these costs associated with each specific event

### ·Reimbursable Payments

- ·EOPA collects money from individuals to combine into a single payment for a group activity such as
  - ·Accompanist fees for UIL events
  - ·Concert tickets

Scholarship-funded private lessons

Concert support and performance assistance

UIL judges and event support

#### **Classroom Expenses**

Sheet music and instructional materials School supplies and teaching aids

Instrument repairs and purchases


